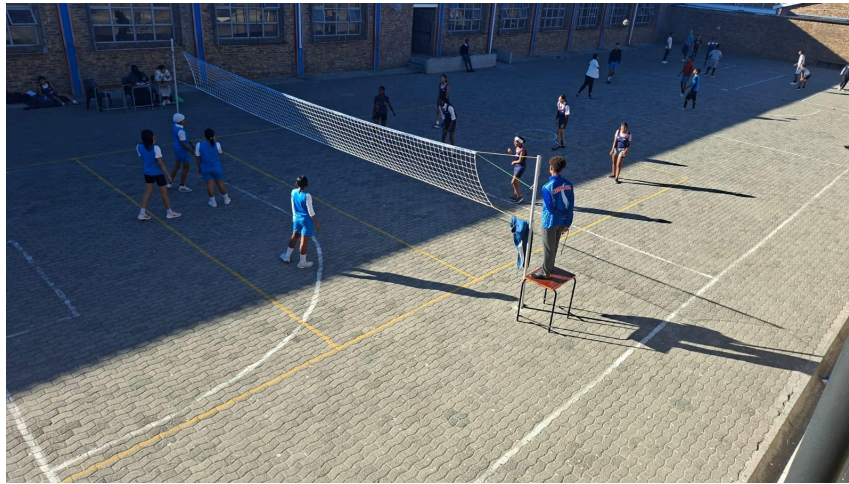


Volleyball
